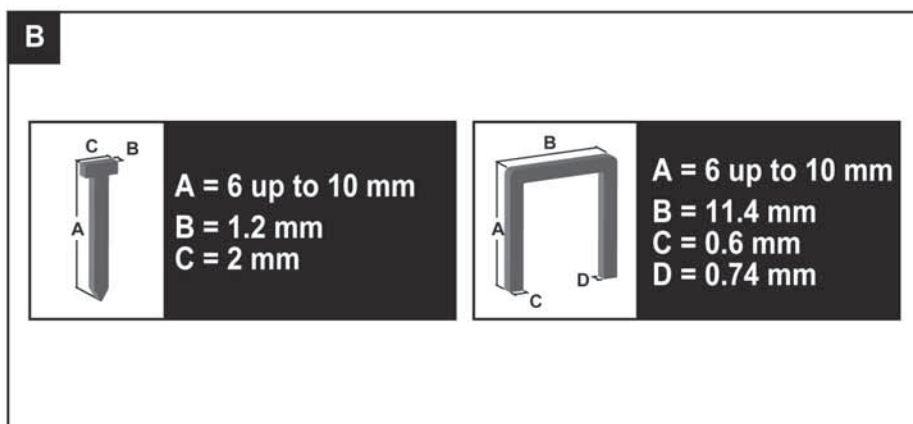
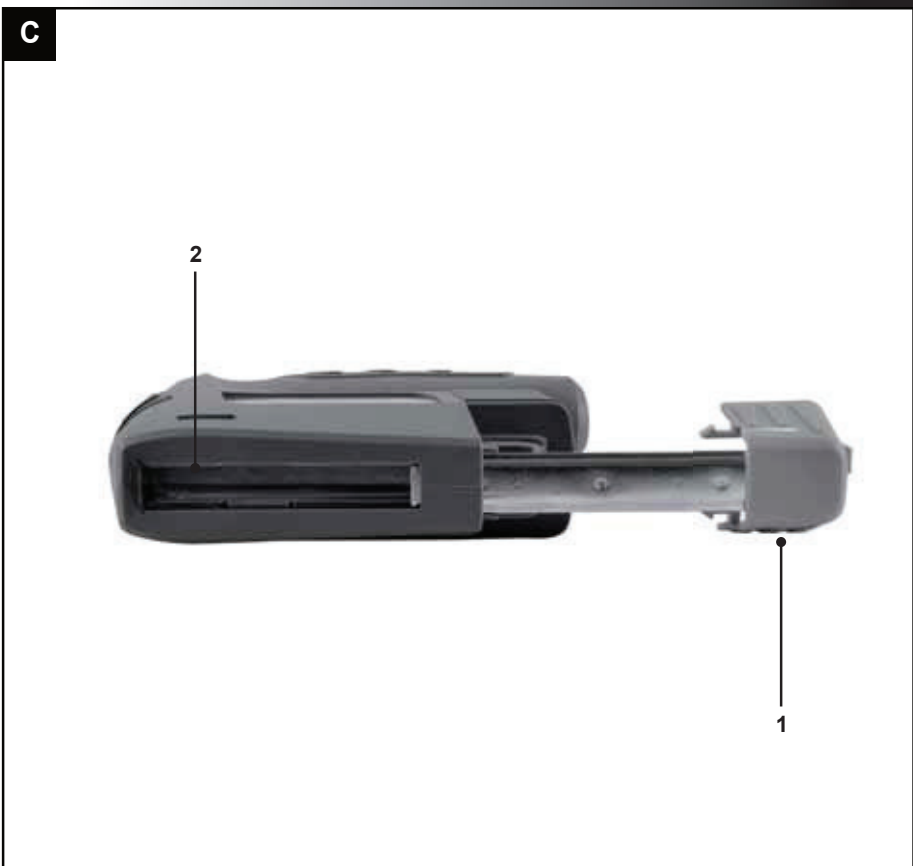


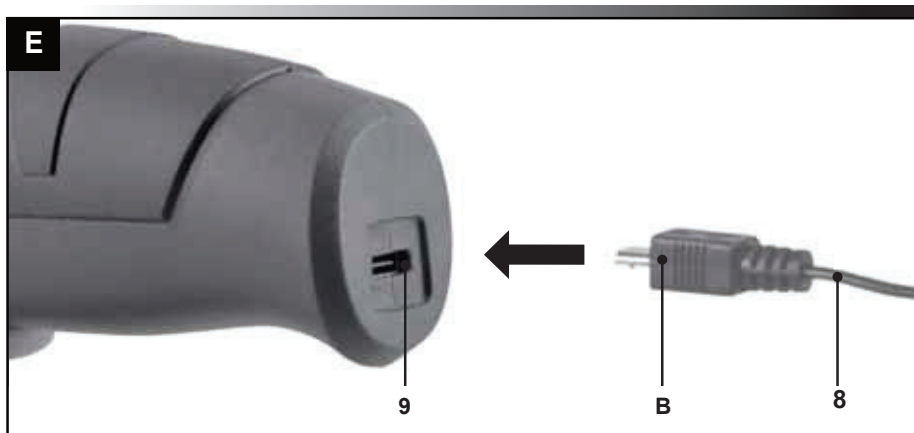

# 1. GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

## **WARNING!**

Carefully read the instruction manual before use.

### **Important safety warnings**

-  Unpack the product carefully and be sure not to throw away any part of the package before having found all components of the product.
-  Keep the product in a dry place out of reach of children.
-  Read all cautions and instructions. The failure to adhere to warning cautions and instructions may result in an accident, fire and/or a serious injury.

### **Packaging**

The product is placed in a package preventing damage during transport. This package is a raw material therefore it can be handed-over for recycling.

### **Instructions for use**

Before beginning to work with the machine, read the following safety rules and instructions for use. Familiarize with operating elements and the proper use of the device. Keep the manual in a safe place for future reference. We recommend keeping the original package including the inner packaging materials, cash voucher and guarantee card for a period of warranty at minimum.

For a case of transportation, pack the machine into the original box from the manufacturer, thus ensuring a maximum protection of the product during a possible transport (e.g. moving or sending into a service station).

### **Note:**

If you hand the machine over to next persons, hand it over together with the manual. Adherence to the attached instructions for use is a precondition for the proper use of the machine. The operation manual includes also instructions for operation, maintenance and repairs.

**The manufacturer does not take any responsibility for accidents or damages resulting from the failure to adhere to this manual.**

## 3. DESCRIPTION

The numbers in the text refer to the diagrams on pages 2 - 4.

1. Reload lever
2. Cartridge shaft
3. Switch
4. "0/1" switch
5. Top
6. Safety pin
7. Cartridge filling level window
8. Charger cable
9. Charging socket
10. Battery indication light

## 4. OPERATION

### Charging the device (Fig. A)

- ✿ Plug the charger cable (8) (included) into an adapter (not included).
- ✿ Plug the charger cable (8) into the machine. (Fig. E)
- ✿ Plug the charger plug into an electrical outlet and wait for a while. The charger indication light (10) will lighten up and show the charging status.

LED	Charger status
Red	Battery charging in progress.
Green	Battery charging finished, battery fully charged.

After the battery is fully charged remove the charger plug from the outlet and remove the small plug from the device.

Fully charging the battery may take up to 2-3 hours.

If the red LED charging indicator starts glowing during operation, this indicates that the battery will soon be empty

### Application (Fig. B)

- ✿ For this tool, use one of the following length for staples or nails:
- ✿ Staples: 6 up to 10 mm
- ✿ Nails: 6 up to 10 mm

### Loading the nails or staples (Fig. C)

- ✿ Choose the correct nail or staple for the job.
- ✿ Hold the tacker with bottom upwards.



- ✿ Open the cartridge shaft (2) by slightly pressing the reload lever (1).
- ✿ Pull the reload lever backwards to open the cartridge shaft (2).

#### **For nails:**

- ✿ Place the nails upside down against the left side of the cartridge shaft (2). The left side also shows a nail symbol on the cartridge shaft, see fig.D.

#### **For staples:**

- ✿ Place the staples upside down in the cartridge shaft (2).
- ✿ Push the reload lever to fully close the cartridge shaft.

- ⚠ **Before loading the tacker, make sure the machine is in “0” position.**
- ⚠ **Never load staples and nail at the same time.**


### **Checking the cartridge shaft**


- ✿ The cartridge filling level window (7) indicates the amount of staples/nails inside the cartridge shaft.

### **Using the tacker**

- ⚠ After every load test the machine on a piece of scrape.

- ✿ Press the “0/1” switch (4) to “1” to unlock the machine.
- ✿ Press the “0/1” switch (4) to “0” to lock the machine.

 **Note:** When not in use, press the “0/1” switch to “0” to lock the machine.

 **Note:** Always store in Lock on “0” position.

### **Placing the tool**

1. Place the tool on workpiece at the spot where the staple or nail should be located.
2. Press the tool down firmly by pressing the machine on the top (5) with one hand.
3. Use your other hand to operate the switch (3).
4. By pressing the machine down firmly you lift the safety of the machine.

#### **⚠ WARNING!**

**The safety of the machine will be lifted when pressure is applied to the safety pin (6) on the bottom of the machine. Always make sure the tacker mouth is in direct contact with the material when pressing the switch.**

### **Stapling**

- ✿ Press the switch (3).

- ⚠ The tool will cause a rebound because of the impact it operates with. Keep this in mind. For long nails and staples this can cause wrong stapling or nailing. When backpressure is applied wrong stapling or nailing can be avoided.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### **⚠ Make sure that the machine is not live when carrying out maintenance work on the motor.**

This machine has been designed to operate over a long period of time with a minimum of maintenance. Continuous satisfactory operation depends upon proper machine care and regular cleaning.

### **Malfunction**

Should the machine fail to function correctly, a number of possible causes and the appropriate solutions are given below:

In case a staple or nail is jammed in the tool, follow the procedure below:

- ✿ Place the machine in "0" position (4).
- ✿ Open the cartridge shaft (2) by pulling the reload lever (1) and let the jammed nails/staples fall out.
- ✿ Reload the machine, see chapter "Loading the nails or staples" for instructions.
- ✿ Test the machine on a piece of scrap.

### **Cleaning**

Regularly clean the device's casing with a soft cloth, preferably after each use. Keep the fan slits free of dust and dirt. Remove tough dirt using a soft cloth, dampened with soapy water. Do not use solvents such as benzene, alcohol, ammonia, etc., which might damage the plastic parts.

### **For the charger**

#### **Intended use**

This tacker has an integrated lithium-ion battery, which you can charge with the included USB charging cable (USB-mains adapter not included).

- a) **The appliance is not to be used by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction.**
- b) **Children being supervised not to play with the appliance.**
- c) Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries!
- d) During charging, batteries must be placed in a well ventilated area!
- e) **Integrated batteries may only be removed for disposal by qualified personnel.**

Opening the housing shell can destroy the power tool. To remove the battery from the power tool, press the On/Off switch (4) until the battery is fully discharged. Unscrew the screws on the housing and remove the housing shell in order to remove the battery. To prevent a short circuit, disconnect the connectors on the battery one at a time and then isolate the poles. Even when fully discharged, the battery still contains a residual capacity, which can be released in case of a short circuit.

## 7. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Operation

- ✿ This product must not be used by children and persons with physical or mental impairments or by inexperienced persons, unless properly trained or schooled in the safe use of the product, or unless they have been properly supervised by a qualified person who will be responsible for their safety.
- ✿ Use extra care if the product is used near children. Always keep the appliance out of reach of children. Children must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the product.
- ✿ Never allow children or persons who do not know the contents of this user's manual to work with the device. Local regulations may set the minimum age of the user. The user is responsible for damages caused to third parties in the machine's working area as a result of its use.
- ✿ Do not use the machine if you are tired, under the influence of alcohol or narcotics.
- ✿ If necessary, use personal protection aids (gloves, work footwear, eye protection, respirators, etc.). Personal protection aids reduce the risk of injury to persons.
- ✿ Dress appropriately. Do not wear loose clothing or jewellery and make sure that your hair, clothing or gloves do not come dangerously close to moving parts. Loose clothing, jewellery or long hair may become caught in the moving parts.
- ✿ Pay constant attention, watch what you are doing and think when working with power tools. Do not use power tools if you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication. A moment of carelessness when working with power tools may lead to serious injury.
- ✿ Prevent the situation where the tool is turned on accidentally. Ensure the trigger switch is in the Off position before connecting the power cord to the power socket. Carrying power tools with the finger on the main trigger switch or connecting the power cord to the power socket when the main trigger switch is in the On position may cause injury.
- ✿ Do not get in your own way. When working, always maintain a firm posture and balance. This will make it possible to better control the power tool in unexpected situations.
- ✿ Use clamps or a vice to fasten the workpiece. It is safer than holding the workpiece in your hand and at the same time you have both hands free to operate the tool.
- ✿ Keep the working area tidy and well illuminated. A cluttered and badly lit work area may lead to injury.
- ✿ Do not work with the power tool in an explosive environment, such as for example areas where there are flammable liquid, gas or powder substances. Sparks are made inside the power tool, which may cause the ignition of flammable powder or vapour.
- ✿ Do not work with materials containing asbestos. Use a dust mask. When working with the tool ensure there is a safe distance from children and other persons. Distractions may lead to a loss of control over the tool.

### Purpose of use

- ✿ This tool is not designed for professional use.
- ✿ Do not use the product for purposes other than those intended.
- ✿ For safety reasons the machine must not be used as a drive engine for any other work tools and tool sets, unless expressly permitted by the manufacturer.

### Instructions for use

- ✿ Turn on and operate the machine as described in the user's manual, carefully follow all instructions.
- ✿ Before carrying out any kind of inspection, maintenance or repairs disconnect the charger power cable from the mains power supply.
- ✿ Use tools in good working condition for tasks for which they are designed.

- ✿ Work only during good visibility or ensure sufficient artificial lighting.
- ✿ Work in a clean and tidy working environment.
- ✿ Make sure that while working you maintain a firm and stable stance. Do not forget that falls represent one of the major causes of injuries during accidents.
- ✿ When drilling metal sheets use a vice and place a piece of wood underneath the sheet. A rotating metal sheet presents a serious risk.
- ✿ Make sure that the drill or screwdriver are not used for work on items under live current, to prevent injury by electrical shock. Before using this tool, check that you know the location of all electrical conductors or cables in the wall (use a metal detector for this purpose).
- ✿ Only store and use the product away from flammable or volatile materials and solutions.
- ✿ Keep the product away from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight and excessive humidity. Do not use in a dusty environment.
- ✿ Do not place the product near heaters, open fires or other appliances or equipment that are sources of heat.
- ✿ Do not spray the product with water or any other liquid. Do not pour water or any other liquids into the appliance. Do not submerge the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- ✿ Never leave the appliance switched on without supervision.
- ✿ Do not touch machine parts until they have come to a complete stop.
- ✿ Allow the motor to cool down before storing the machine in a closed room.
- ✿ Under no circumstances should you repair or alter the product yourself. Entrust all repairs and adjustments of this product to an authorised service centre or the vendor. Tampering with the appliance during the warranty period may void the warranty.
- ✿ The manufacturer is not responsible for damages caused by incorrect use of this product or its accessories. Such damages include food spoilage, injuries, burns, scalding, fire, etc.

## Electrical safety

### **ATTENTION!**

**Read all the safety warnings and all instructions. If you fail to follow the provided warnings and instructions an injury caused by electrical shock could occur as well as fire or serious injuries.**

### **Note:**

Keep these warnings and instructions for future use. The term "electric power tool" in all warnings relates to your tool powered from the mains (it has a power cord installed) or cordless tools (without a power cord).

- ✿ The charger of the cordless device can be connected to any power plug, preventing discharge, that is installed according to norms in force.
- ✿ The plug must be powered at 230V ~ 50Hz.
- ✿ Disconnect the charger if you will not be using it for a long time, if you are changing the tool or performing maintenance on the tool.
- ✿ The power plug on the tool's charger cord must correspond to the power socket. Never modify the power plug in any way. Do not use any power plug adapters for tools protected by grounding. Unmodified power plugs and corresponding power sockets reduce the risk of injury by electrical shock.
- ✿ Do not touch grounded surfaces such as pipes, heaters, electrical stoves and refrigerators when working with the machine. When your body is grounded the risk of injury by electrical shock is increased.

- ✿ Do not expose the electrical tool to rain or a moist environment. The entry of water into the electrical tool increases the risk of injury by electrical shock.
- ✿ Handle the power cord with care. Never use the power cord to carry or move the tool and do not pull on it when you want to disconnect the tool from the power grid. Prevent the tool coming into contact with greasy, hot and sharp items or moving parts. A damaged or tangled up power cord increases the risk of injury by electrical shock.
- ✿ When working with electric power tools in a moist environment, the power circuit must have current protection installed (RSD - Residual Current Device). The use of a residual current device reduces the risk of injury by electrical shock.

### Safety instructions for the battery and charger

- ✿ Use only the battery and charger supplied with this tool.
- ✿ Connect the charger only to a mains power socket with a voltage of 230V.
- ✿ Protect the battery and charger from moisture. Do not use the device in an outdoor environment.
- ✿ Disconnect the charger from the mains power socket when the charger is not being used, before cleaning the charger or before performing repairs on it.
- ✿ Take special care of the battery. Prevent the battery from falling on to a hard surface and do not expose the battery to the effects of pressure or other excessive mechanical stress. Keep the battery at a safe distance from excessive heat or cold.
- ✿ Do not attempt to repair or disassemble the battery or the charger. If any part is damaged, have it repaired by a qualified technician or send it for repair to an authorised service centre or the vendor.
- ✿ Charge the battery only when the ambient air temperature is between 10°C and 40°C. A charged battery may be used to power tools in operating conditions at a temperature between 0°C and 50°C. If the battery is not being used store it in a dry place at a temperature between 10°C and 30°C.

### **⚠ IMPORTANT! DANGER!**

Never short circuit the battery contacts and do not expose the battery to moisture. Do not store the battery together with metal items and parts, which could cause a short circuit of the battery contacts. The battery could overheat, catch on fire or explode.

- ✿ If any person comes into contact with the electrolyte or another liquid or substance found in the battery, they must immediately wash this substance away with large amounts of water. If these substances come into contact with eyes, flush the eyes out with large amounts of water and immediately seek medical treatment.
- ✿ Do not throw rechargeable batteries into a fire or into water. Otherwise an explosion could occur. A rechargeable battery should not be thrown out with ordinary household waste, regardless of the fact whether it has or has not been used. In accordance with valid regulations you should take the battery to a collection point or put it into the container labelled "Used Batteries" in our store.
- ✿ Only charge the battery in a charger designated by the manufacturer. A charger appropriate for one type of battery creates a fire hazard when used with another type of battery.
- ✿ Only use the electric power tool with a battery intended to be used in it. The use of different batteries may lead to a risk of injury or a fire hazard.
- ✿ If you are not using the battery, store it away from metal items, such as paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small items, which could lead to the short circuit of the battery contacts. Short circuiting the battery contacts may cause burns or a fire.

## 8. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

### Maintenance

#### **⚠ WARNING!**

**It is recommended that all the repair or replacement for this tool shall be performed by a qualified service technician. Contact or visit the nearest Menards store for more information.**

#### **⚠ WARNING!**

**Always use only a soft, dry cloth to clean your screwdriver, never use any detergent or alcohol.**

**Disconnect the power unit from the main supply before cleaning.**

#### **⚠ CAUTION!**

**No chemical agents are approved for use in cleaning this power tool. Clean with a dry cloth or towel only.**

#### **⚠ ATTENTION!**

**Disconnect the charger if you will not be using it for a long time, if you are changing the tool or performing maintenance on the tool.**

- ✿ This tool does not require any special maintenance. The same applies to the electrical parts of the tool.
- ✿ Check whether the device is showing signs of wear.
- ✿ If the charger is damaged (cover, conductors or connector), immediately arrange its replacement at the vendors service centre.
- ✿ Regular care for the machine will ensure not only a long lifetime and performance.
- ✿ Before use always visually check for worn or damaged parts.
- ✿ Replace damaged or worn parts. To ensure that the machine always remains balanced, always replace the entire set of the worn or damaged tools.
- ✿ Worn or damaged machine parts may only be replaced at an authorised service centre or the vendor.
- ✿ Before cleaning disconnect this product from the power source.
- ✿ To clean the plastic parts of the product, use a soft cloth dipped in lukewarm water. Do not use aggressive cleaning products and solvents as this could damage the surface of the appliance.
- ✿ Do not clean the machine under running water or submerge under water.
- ✿ After changing the working tool, check that the working tool is secured in its storage position.
- ✿ Do not use working tools that are not proportioned for placement into the tang in the magazine.
- ✿ Do not overload the electric power tool. Use the right type of electric power tool for your work. When the correct electric power tool is used, the work result will be performed better and more safety.
- ✿ If it is not possible to turn the main trigger switch on or off, do not work with the tool. All electric power tools with a trigger switch that do not work are dangerous and must be repaired.
- ✿ If you are not working with the tool, store it out of the reach of children and prevent persons not informed about the operation of the tool or this user's manual to work with the tool. An electric power tool in the hands of an unqualified person is dangerous.
- ✿ Perform maintenance on the tool. Check for deviation or blockage of the moving parts, damage of individual parts and other factors which could affect the operation of the tool. If the tool is damaged, have it repaired

before using it. Many accidents are caused by neglected maintenance of a tool. Properly maintained cutting tools with sharp cutting edges are less prone to jamming in a workpiece and are easier to handle.

- ✿ Maintain cutting tools sharp and clean. Properly maintained cutting tools with sharp cutting edges are less prone to jamming in a workpiece and are easier to handle.
- ✿ Use electric power tools, accessories, working tools, etc. according to these instructions in a manner appropriate for the given type of electric power tool and take into consideration the work conditions and the type of work that you will be performing. Using electric power tools for purposes other than those for which they were designed may be dangerous.
- ✿ Damaged switches must be replaced at an authorised service centre or the vendor. Do not use electric power tools that cannot be turned on and off.
- ✿ Do not leave electric power tools turned on without supervision. Always turn the tool off and wait for it to come to a complete stop before putting it down.
- ✿ Use hearing protection. Excessive noise levels may cause hearing damage.
- ✿ When performing tasks, where the working tools may come into contact with hidden electrical conductors, hold the electric power tool by the insulated part that is intended to be held. A work tool that comes into contact with a "live" electrical conductor, will cause the uninsulated parts of the tool to become live and may subsequently cause injury by electrical shock to the operator.
- ✿ For repairs contact an authorised service centre or vendor who will use original spare parts. This will ensure the correct operation of the electric power tool.

### **⚠ ATTENTION!**

**Using any accessories or tools not recommended in this user's manual may increase the risk of injury. Always use only original spare parts.**

- ✿ Clean the tool after the completion of every work task.
- ✿ Do not use worn or damaged drill bits and drilling extension pieces. Such tools may overload the motor and lower effectiveness.
- ✿ Take proper care to prevent the motor from damage by oil or water.
- ✿ Regularly check that the tool has not been damaged during the course of standard operation. Make sure that all parts are correctly connected and do not use this product if any of its parts has been damaged or lost.
- ✿ When inserting the battery into the charger, ensure that the battery is inserted in the correct manner and that there are no materials between the battery contacts, e.g. soils.
- ✿ The battery and the charger should be protected from heat and the sun. Do not expose these products to extreme temperatures.
- ✿ Do not use the device in an outdoor environment.
- ✿ Use only the charger supplied with this tool.
- ✿ If the product is damaged or malfunctions, contact an authorised service centre or the vendor.

### **Storage**

- ✿ Store the tool in a dry location at a sufficient distance from heat sources or dangerous vapours.
- ✿ Do not place any other items on the machine.



## 9. DISPOSAL



The machine, rechargeable batteries, accessories and packaging should be sorted for environmental friendly recycling.

Do not dispose of power tools and batteries/rechargeable batteries into household waste!

## Záruční podmínky

Prodávající poskytuje kupujícímu na výrobek záruku v trvání 24 měsíců od převzetí výrobku kupujícím. Záruka se poskytuje za dále uvedených podmínek. Záruka se vztahuje pouze na nové spotřební zboží prodané spotřebiteli pro běžné domácí použití. Práva z odpovědnosti za vady (reklamaci) může kupující uplatnit buď u prodávajícího, u kterého byl výrobek zakoupen nebo v níže uvedeném autorizovaném servisu. Kupující je povinen reklamaci součinností nutnou pro ověření existence reklamované vady. Záruka sa vztahuje iba na spotrebný tovar predaný spotrebiteľovi na bežné domáce použitie. ## Jótállási jegy

A termék gyártója: **FAST ČR, a.s.** (Černokostelec-ká1621, Řičany u Prahy 251 01, Csehország)

A **FAST Hungary Kft.** (2310, Szigetszentmiklós, Kántor u. 10) mint a termék magyarországi importőre jótállási jegyen feltüntetett típusú és gyártási számú készülékekre jótállást biztosít a fogyasztók számára az alábbi feltételek szerint:

A FAST Hungary Kft. a termékre a fogyasztó részére történő átadástól (vásárlástól), illetve ha az üzembe helyezést a terméket értékesítő vállalkozás vagy annak megbízottja végzi, az üzembe helyezettől számított **24 hónapig** tartó időtartamra vállal jótállást. A termék **alkotórészeire és tartozékaira** (pl. akkumulátor) a jótállási idő a termék átadásától számított **12 hónap**.

A jótállási igény a jótállási jeggyel, a vásárlástól (üzembe helyezettől) számított 1 évig a terméket értékesítő vállalkozásnál, illetve a jótállási jegyen feltüntetett hivatalos szerviznél közvetlenül is, míg a 13. hónaptól a 24. hónapig kizárólag a hivatalos szerviznél érvényesíthető.

Jótállási jegy hiányában a fogyasztói szerződés megkötését bizonyítottan kell tekinteni, ha a fogyasztó bemutatja a termék ellenértékének megfizetését hitelem érdemlően igazoló bizonylatot. Mindezek érdekében kérjük tisztelt Vásárlóinkat, hogy őrizzék meg a fizetési bizonylatot is. A jótállási időn belüli meghibásodás esetén a fogyasztó - választása szerint - (i) a hibás termék díjmentes kijavítását vagy kicserélését követelheti, kivéve, ha a választott igény teljesítése lehetetlen, vagy ha az a jótállásra kötelezettnek a fogyasztó által érvényesíteni kívánt másik igény teljesítésével összehasonlítva aránytalan többletköltséget eredményezne, vagy (ii) ha a kötelezett a kijavítást, illetve kicserélést nem vállalata, vagy e kötelezettségének megfelelő határidőn belül, a fogyasztó érdekeit kímélve nem tud eleget tenni, vagy ha a fogyasztónak a kijavításhoz vagy kicseréléshez fűződő érdeke megszűnt, akkor a fogyasztó megfelelő árleszállítást igényelhet, vagy a hibát a kötelezett költségére maga kijavíthatja vagy mással kijavíttathatja vagy elállhat a szerződéstől. Jelenképpen a hiba miatt elállásnak nincs helye. A fogyasztó a választott jogáról másira térhet át. Az áttéréssel okozott költséget köteles a jótállásra kötelezettnek megfizetni, kivéve, ha az áttérésre a jótállásra kötelezett adott okot, vagy az áttérés egyébként indokolt volt. A fogyasztó a hiba felfedezését követően késedelem nélkül, legkésőbb a felfedezéstől számított 2 hónapon belül köteles a hibát közölni. A bejelentés kapcsán kérjük vegye figyelembe, hogy a jótállási igény kizárólag a jótállási

határidőben érvényesíthető! Ugyanakkor, ha a jótállásra kötelezett jótállási kötelezettségének megfelelő határidőben nem tesz eleget, a jótállási igény a fogyasztó erre irányuló felhívásában tűzött megfelelő határidő elteltétől számított 3 hónapon belül akkor is érvényesíthető bíróság előtt, ha a jótállási idő már eltelt. E határidő elmulasztása jogvesztéssel jár. A jótállási kötelezettség teljesítésével kapcsolatosan felmerülő költségek a jótállás kötelezettjét terhelik.

A 151/2003. (IX.22.) Kormányrendeletben meghatározott tartós fogyasztási cikk meghibásodása miatt a vásárlástól (üzembe helyezettől) számított három munkanapon belül érvényesített csereigény esetén a terméket értékesítő vállalkozás nem hivatkozhat aránytalan többletköltségre, hanem köteles a tartós fogyasztási cikket kicserélni, feltéve, hogy a meghibásodás a rendeltetészerű használatot akadályozza. Kijavítás esetén a fogyasztási cikkből csak új alkatrész kerülhet beépítésre. A jótállásra kötelezett törekszik arra, hogy a kijavítás vagy kicserélés 15 napon belül megtörténjen. A rögzített bekötésű, illetve a 10kg-nál súlyosabb, vagy tömegközlekedési eszközön kézi csomagként nem szállítható fogyasztási cikket az üzemeltetés helyén kell megjavítani. Gwarancja obejmuje tylko produkty zakupione w Polsce i jest ważna tylko na terytorium Rzeczypospolitej Polskiej. Gwarancja obejmuje tylko produkty funkcjonujące w warunkach gospodarstwa domowego (nie dotyczy produktów oznaczonych jako „Professional“). Zgłoszenia gwarancyjne można dokonać w autoryzowanej sieci serwisowej lub w sklepie, gdzie produkt został nabyty. Użytkownik jest zobowiązany zgłosić usterkę niezwłocznie po jej wykryciu, a najpóźniej w ostatnim dniu obowiązywania okresu gwarancyjnego. ### Gwarancja zostaje unieważniona, jeśli:
